Drop-off Center Information

Hours:

Drop-off Center hours are Tuesdays and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. until 3:45 p.m.

Permits:

Permits are available at the New Fairfield Land Use Department on the lower level of Town Hall. To obtain a permit, you need to show the registration for your vehicle and your driver's license or proof of residency and/or land ownership. Permits are effective from January to December.

Fee Schedule:

- \$10.00 Passenger cars – 2nd no charge.
- \$10.00 Vehicles with combination plates using the Drop Off Center for Personal use only. 2nd no charge.
- \$50.00 Vehicles with combination plates using the Drop Off Center for commercial purposes. 2nd permit at no charge if for a passenger, combination for personal use only.
- \$50.00 Commercial vehicles.
- \$ 5.00 Any additional Commercial vehicles permit.
- \$20.00 Sherman residents.
- \$ 5.00 Seniors over 65. – 2nd no charge.
- No Free Passes.

Recyclables:

Newspapers should be bundled with a maximum thickness of 12", or placed in brown paper bags. The Drop-off Center will not take unbundled newspapers. Any material which is delivered with the paper may be disposed with the newspapers.

Corrugated cardboard should be bundled. The bundles should measure no more than 3' on each side and be no thicker than 12". The Drop-off Center will not take unbundled cardboard.

Household recyclables should be disposed of in the blue bags available at local stores. All area haulers use this distinction to separate the recyclables from regular household trash. Household recyclables are food and beverage containers made of metal, glass, or plastic. Detergent bottles are also recyclable. Recyclable plastic containers will have a **1** or **2** inside the recycling symbol. Labels and lids do not have to be removed from the containers. However, containers must be rinsed and free of food debris or other contents.

Household Hazardous Wastes:

The Town attempts to make available access to a Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Day once a year. Unfortunately, since the day is expensive, the funding does not survive the budget process every year. Please hold on to your wastes (stored in original packaging) until a day is announced. There will be ads and articles in the *Citizen News* and *Danbury News Times*.

Other Wastes:

The Drop-off center accepts most types of residential waste. If you have any questions, you call ahead to check directly with them.

Automated Waste Disposal:

*Residents may use the Automated Waste Disposal (AWD) facilities at 307 White Street in Danbury. All materials which can be taken to the transfer station can be taken to AWD. AWD is open from 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and from 7:00 a.m. until 1:p.m on Saturday.
