Approval of Minutes

Transfer Stations – report on current changes

No new changes were reported. New Milford and Redding are currently only taking MSW and Recycling.

Fire Extinguisher Collection Program

J. Heaton-Jones shared that Tom McSherry from Fire Control Services has offered to take fire extinguishers from municipalities. They will charge \$2 per unit if you drop them off at their New Milford Facility. If a town wants them picked up, the cost is \$5 per unit with a minimum of 10. They will not start the program until after the state changes the restrictions surrounding COVID 19. They will do a monthly milk run. Transfer Stations Operators will need to notify them if they need a pick-up no later then the 27th of the month. The milk run will be the first week of each month. More details will be shared when restrictions have changed.

Update on Rid-Litter Days

The town of Bridgewater is planning a Rid-Litter event on April 4th. The event has been modified to respect the concerns around social distancing. No other towns reported moving forward with scheduled events. Many have been cancelled.

Update on Billboard contest Ceremony
