Approval of Minutes

HRRA New Recycling Coordinator

J. Baum introduced the HRRA new hire, Lily Keefe, Recycling Coordinator and Educator.

Annual Recycling Billboard Contest

The contest templates are ready for pickup. The artwork is due to local coordinators by February 24th and local judging should be completed by March 3rd. The contest theme is "Recycle Outside the Bin! Choose a material that can be recycled but does not go in your mixed recycling bin." The contest information is posted on the HRRA website, including a drop-down menu of materials that can be recycled outside the mixed recycling bin.

Bottle Bill Expansion

J. Baum shared information from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection on the Bottle Bill expansion on the types of beverages that have been added to the bill, effective January 1, 2023. Beverages required to have a deposit refund as of January 1, 2023, include beer, soda, water, sports drinks, energy drinks, juice, hard seltzer, hard cider, tea & coffee, kombucha, plant water (e.g., coconut water), and carbonated spirit-based beverages.

The deposit amount will increase from \$.05 to \$.10 beginning January 01, 2024.

Goals for 2023

- T. Carlson shared the Town of Ridgefield will be focusing on increasing participation in the food scraps recycling program and re-introducing organics programs in schools.
- J. Fascitelli shared the Town of Wilton is launching a Food Scraps Recycling program at the transfer station.
