- A. Miles provided an update for the Town of Newtown.
 - The town is continuing to work on the Save As You Throw program and will be posting weekly recycling messages at the transfer station.
- S. Conn shared the Town of Brookfield's focus is to repurpose the equipment, furniture, and supplies from Center School.
- P. Silva shared the Town of Redding received a new cash register for the transfer station that will allow tracking of different materials.
- A. Dinho shared the Town of Bridgewater hosted their Fall Bulky Drop Off day at the town garage and it was very successful.

J. Heaton-Jones shared the CT Recycling Coalition will be hosting a webinar series "Train the Trainer" for recycling coordinators. The webinar will be held in conjunction with material recovery facility operators. Each webinar will focus on a different recyclable material.
