B-3 DOT INSPECTION **Must be completed for each vehicle that is required to have an annual inspection**

For the safety of the public and transfer station operators, a copy of the RECORD OF ANNUAL INSPECTION must be submitted with any and all vehicles the applicant will be using to conduct business in the HRRRA region and for which an inspection is required by state or federal law. A hauler must not use any such vehicle unless each component identified on the RECORD OF ANNUAL INSPECTION has passed an inspection by a qualified inspector who has training or certification to inspect and maintain commercial motor vehicles at least once during the preceding 12 months.

Safety inspections can be performed at either a DMV office equipped for inspections or at designated emissions inspection stations run by the state's emissions inspection contractor. Inspections are performed at the DMV facilities in Danbury, Enfield, Hamden, Northwest (Winsted), Old Saybrook, Waterbury, Wethersfield, and Willimantic and at the emissions inspection stations in Bridgeport, Danbury, Darien, East Lyme, Manchester, North Haven, North Windham, Southington, Taftville, Thomaston, and Waterbury.
